2010 HP Rifle Program - M1A Practice Match

This M1A match is intended to be practice and preparation for the annual NRA M1A match held during the National Matches at Camp Perry. Rifles other than an M1A are allowed.

Date: July 24th, 2010

Location: SSA club grounds. 5426 Footville-Richmond Rd. Richmond Township, OH 44003

Directions: I-90 to SR11 exit 228. SR11 South to SR 307. East on 307 to SR193. North on SR193 to Footville Richmond Rd. East on Footville Richmond Rd. to Club Property approximately 2 mi. on the right. [MapQuest link](#). (Hold control key + click to follow)

Time to arrive: Front gate will be open from 7:30 am until 8:30 am for sign in and squadding.

Squadding: Sign in and squadding is at the building just inside the gate between 7:30 and 8:30 am with final adjustments made on the 300 yard line. Match will begin at approximately 9:00 am. Four relays are planned. All competitors must present themselves when their relay is called, and report for his duty in the pits before they seal to be scored in this event.

Time of Firing: Pits will seal at 9 a.m. Firing will begin thereafter from the 300 yard line.

Range capacity: 64 with 4 relays. This match is limited to 40 shooters.

Entries at the match: Until 8:45 am...

Entries by mail: None

Rules: Current SSA & NRA Competition Rules will apply.

Eligibility: SSA & Non SSA members are welcome. All entrants of this match should be experienced NMC shooters. Competitors will sign a 2010 SSA liability agreement. Age limit is 14 years or older. (Note 1) All rifles shall have a known 200 yard zero, minimum. (Note 2)

Fees: \$15 per shooter. Solon Members are free. Junior shooters pay \$5.

Rifles Allowed:

M1A semi-automatic rifle as per NRA Rule 3.1.1. Caliber .308/7.62 mm, metallic sights. No bipods, adjustable stocks, or artificial support allowed. Slings permitted. Other safe service rifles will be allowed. Call for details.

Ammunition: Competitors must supply their own ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted.

Sights: Metallic Sights Only

Target: SR-3

Course of fire:

No alibis will be allowed

Match 1 Prone Slow Fire.
5 sighter shots from any position and
20 shots for record in a time limit of
25 minutes @ 300 yards

Match 2 Sitting/kneeling Rapid Fire (Note 4)
10 shots fired in a time limit of 60 seconds
@ 300 yards.

Match 3 Prone Rapid Fire (Note 4)
10 shots for record in a time limit of 70 seconds
@ 300 yards.

Match 4 Standing Slow Fire
10 shots fired in a time limit of 10 minutes
@ 300 yards.

Match 5 The match winner, aggregate of 1-4

Note 1 – The Match RSO may waive the age requirement upon the presentation of evidence that the applicant has successfully competed in other shooting competitions or can provide satisfactory proof of having demonstrated the ability to safely handle the pistol or rifle to be used in that event.

Note 2 - If your rifle does not have a known zero, you must notify the line officer.

Note 4 – NRA 2009 rules no longer require shooters to stand and load in the rapids.
