M1 for Vets Benefit CMP As-Issued Military Rifle Match

Date: Sunday, May 23rd 2010

Location: SSA club grounds. 5426 Footville-Richmond Rd. Richmond Township, OH 44003

Directions: I-90 to SR11 exit 228. SR11 South to SR 307. East on 307 to SR193. North on SR193 to Footville-Richmond Rd. East on Footville-Richmond Rd. to Club Property approximately 2 mi. on the right.

Time to arrive: Front gate will be open from 8:30 to 9:30 AM

Squadding: Sign up and squadding will take place from 8:30AM to 9:30AM at the barn inside the front gate, with final adjustments made on the line. Pit changes will be scheduled as required. Four relays are planned. A competitor who fails to present himself when his relay is called, or fails to show in the pits before they seal, may lose his right to compete in this event.

Time of Firing: Pits will seal at 9:50 AM. Firing will begin at 10:00 AM from the 200 yard line.

Rules: Current SSA & CMP Competition Rules will apply.

Eligibility: Participants will sign a CMP eligibility affidavit and liability agreement along with a SSA hold harmless agreement. Age limit is 14 years or older. (Note 1) All rifles shall have a known 200 yard zero. (Note 2)

Fees: \$20 per shooter, \$10 for Juniors, \$10 for re-shoots (depending on time and interest) All entry fees will be donated by Solon Sportsmen to M1 for Vets organization.

Rifles Allowed: As-Issued US M1 Garand, US M1 Carbine, M1941 Johnson, US 1903/A3 Springfield, US 1917, US Krag, and manually operated foreign military rifles. A limited number of M1 rifles will be available to borrow, please RSVP if a rifle is needed. Other rifles will be permitted; however, they will be recorded as out-of-competition and not eligible for achievement pins.

Awards: Gold, Silver or Bronze Achievement Pins per 2010 CMP cut scores. *Garands/M1 Carbine/1941 Johnson:* Gold: 280+, Silver: 272-279, Bronze: 262-271; *1903/A3:* Gold: 280+, Silver: 273-279, Bronze: 262-272; *Vintage Military Rifle:* Gold: 278+, Silver: 271-277, Bronze: 258-270

Ammunition: CMP .30-06 ammo will be available for purchase and sold at current CMP's price to the club, expect \$15-\$20 for 40 rounds. Otherwise competitors must supply their own ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted.

Sights: Metallic Sights Only

Course of Fire: As-Issued Military Rifle Match Course A

Stage 1: Slow Fire prone – 5 sighters (Note 3) and 10 shots for record in a time limit of 15 minutes.

Stage 2: Rapid fire – standing to prone - 10 shots for record in a time limit of 70 seconds. (80 seconds if bolt guns are on the line.) (Note 4)

Stage 3: Slow fire standing – 10 shots for record in a time limit of 10 minutes.

Note 1 – Rule 4.4.6 The CMP or sanctioned match sponsors may waive the age requirement upon the presentation of evidence that the applicant has successfully competed in other shooting competitions or can provide satisfactory proof of having demonstrated the ability to safely handle the pistol or rifle to be used in that event.

Note 2 – If your rifle does not have a known 200 yard zero, you must notify the line officer before firing.

Note 3 – Sighting shots may be taken from the sitting or prone position.

Note 4 – Competitors who have a valid physical condition or disability that prevents them from moving from standing to the prone position safely may request permission from the Range Officer to begin the rapid-fire stage in the prone position. They may not shoulder the rifle until the firing time begins and they may not fire a shot until after a shooter who was standing fires the first shot.
